

Stage 8 Bay 8 SOMETHING SMELLS

RULES: Practical Shooting Handbook, Latest Edition **COURSE DESIGNER:** Richard Lively

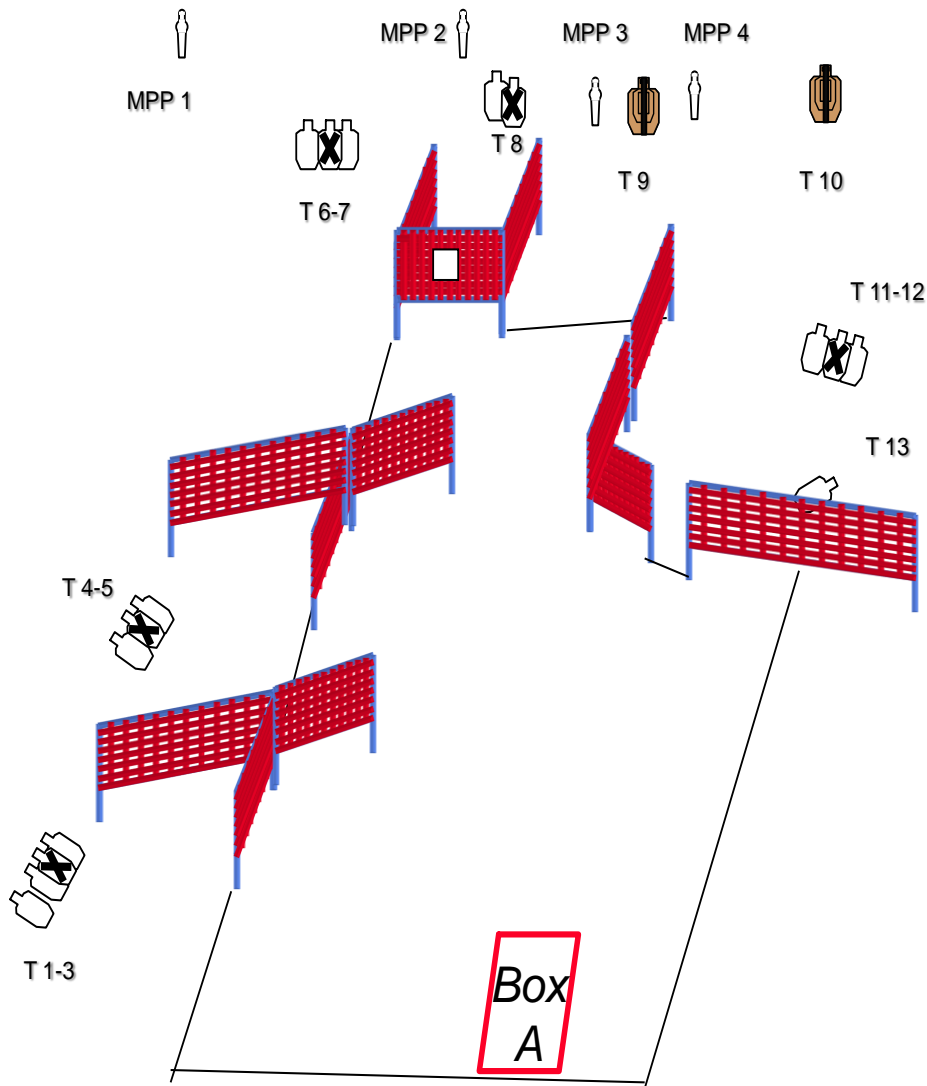
START POSITION: Standing in box A, handgun loaded and holstered, hands relaxed at sides.

STAGE PROCEDURE

At start signal, engage targets as they become visible from within fault lines. All walls go to the ground and up to infinity. The starting box is part of the shooting area.

SCORING

SCORING: Comstock, 30 rounds, 150 points
TARGETS: 13 IPSC, 4 MPP
SCORED HITS: Best per IPSC, steel down = 1A
START-STOP: Audible - Last shot
PENALTIES: Procedural. -10
 No-shoot hit. -10
 Miss. -10



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SETUP NOTES: T 9 -10 are "skunk targets". Standard metric target with 3" vertical stripe down center. Targets placed so that there are no shoot thru concerns, T 1-5 placed to avoid 180 trap by either right or left hand shooters
